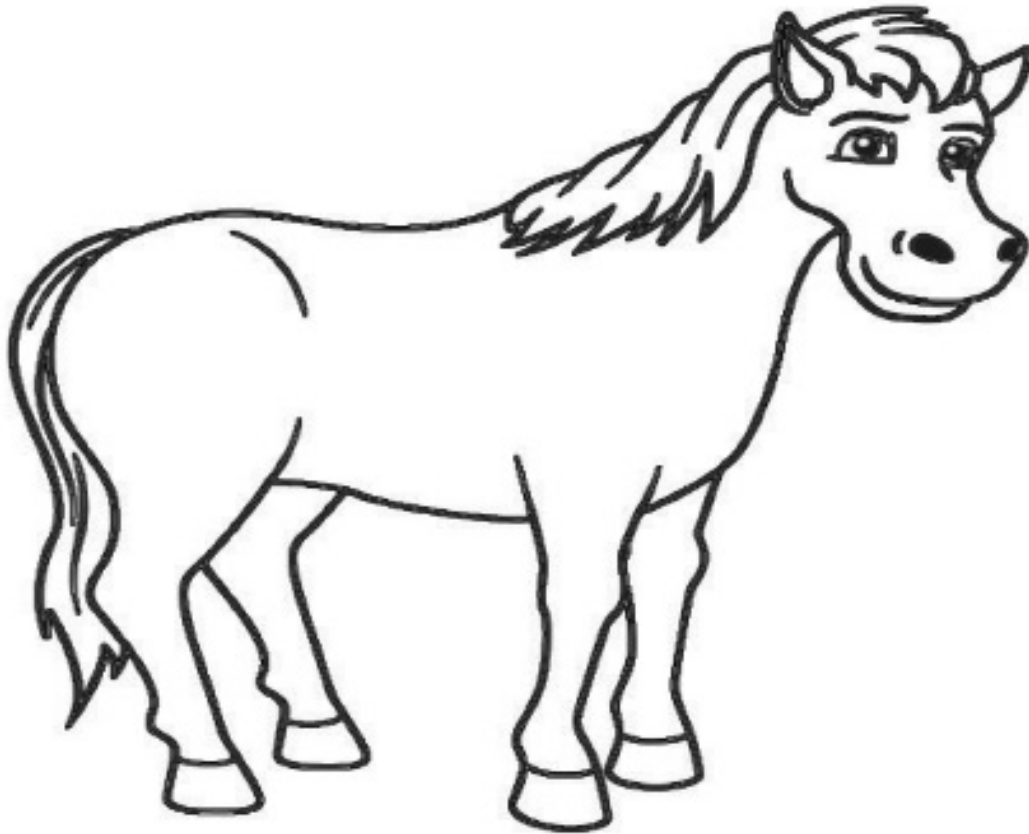

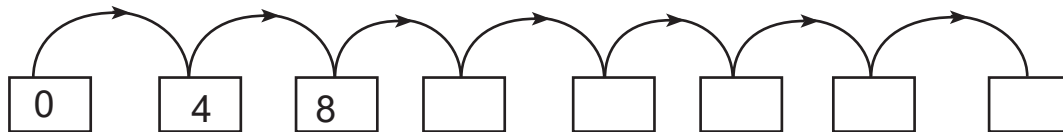

(c) 51 boys and 48 girls study in class 2. How many students study in class 2 altogether?

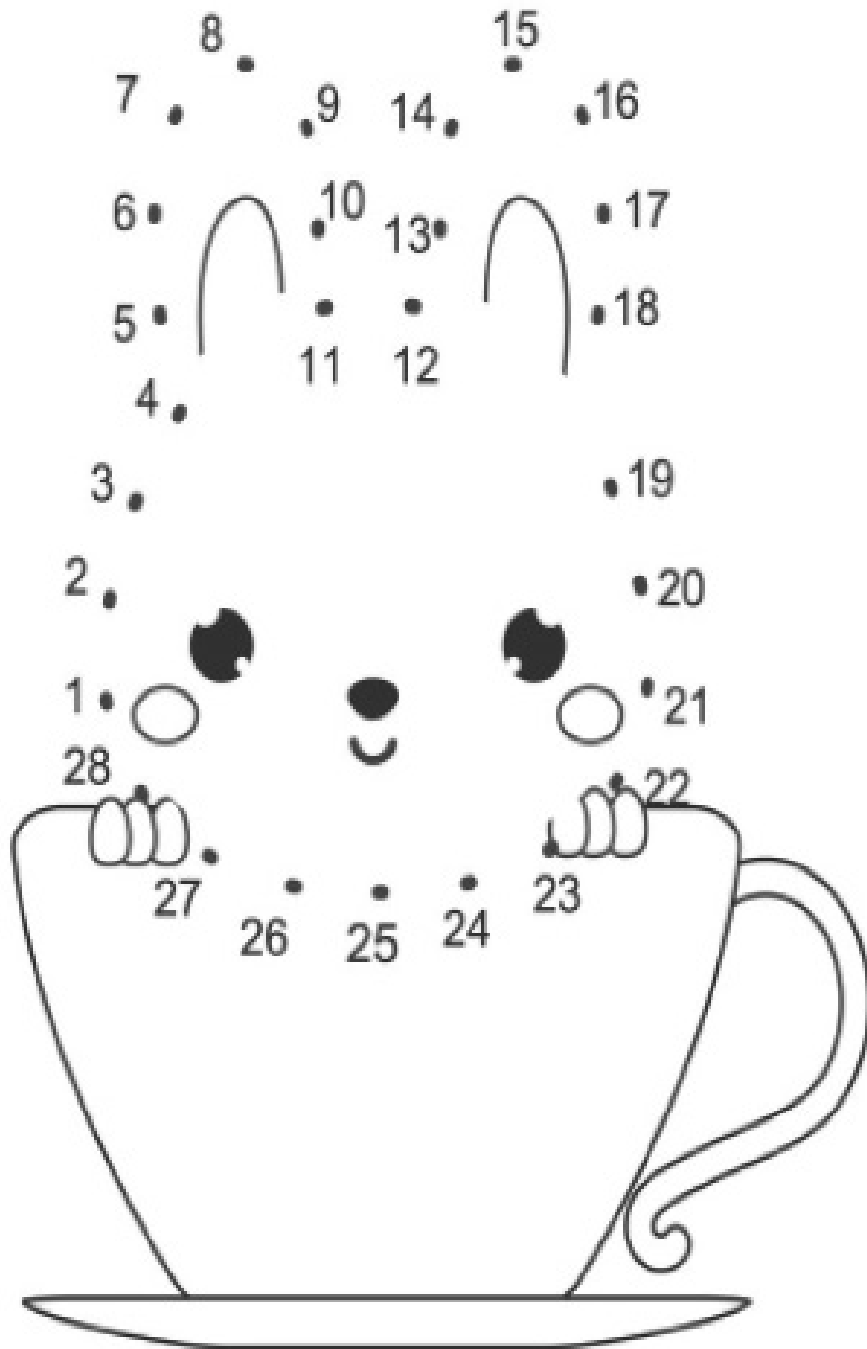
